

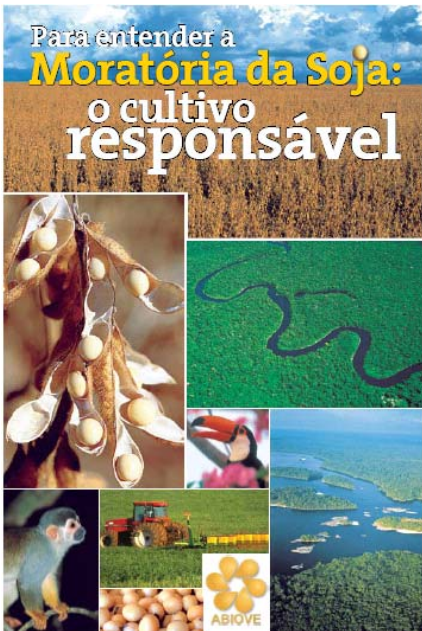

## UNDERSTANDING THE SOY MORATORIUM: RESPONSIBLE CULTIVATION



To explain the Soy Moratorium and to disseminate environmental awareness among producers, showing the best agricultural practices and containing information on the Brazilian Forest Code, the Soybean Working Group (GTS), formed by the corporate sector and organizations of the civil society, created the booklet "Understanding the Soy Moratorium: Responsible Cultivation".

A 13,000 copies edition, the Soy Moratorium booklet will be distributed to producers of the region covered by this initiative, to local technical services, local warehousing units, teaching entities and other interested parties.



Each copy of the booklet has a poster with a summary of the main messages to producers, such as What is the Moratorium? - Proposals and objectives - How is it being implemented? - Participants, etc.

In addition, it contains tips on Environmental and Social Management, handling and conservation, which should be used by local producers.
